

It's 2016, and Planet Earth is now being ruled by ArtVader. Artvader detests artists, and has assumed the mission to eliminate all forms of art from Earth.




12. I ASK QUESTIONS

ACTIVITY 5: Ask a Question

1	Click on Layouts. You should chose a layout that has four zones because you will be asking four questions.
2	Click on Camera and Albums to insert photos in the four zones(four works, four colours, four tools, four photos, etc.)
2	Click on Add Activity.
3	Click on Ask a Question and record your question, For example, you can ask "Which work is not by Jean-Paul Riopelle? Which work doesn't belong?"
4	Circle the correct answer with your finger and click on the checkmark.
5	You can add a question to go with the same photos.
6	Click on Done.
7	Click on Done again.
8	You can now create as many activities as you like for your game.
9	Give your game a name by clicking under the image. You must include the artist's name in your title: For example, The Colours of Riopelle.
10	Add a short description of your game and choose a category, Arts for example. Select the age and language of your players, and decide if you want to publish your game online so that it's available to everyone!
11	Click on Save Game. You can now share your game:-)

ACTIVITY 3 : Play a Video

- 1 Click on Backgrounds to create your background.
- 2 Click on Add Activity.
- 3 Click on Play a Video.
- 4 Go into Safari and copy the video links you bookmarked.
- 5 Paste the URL link into the blue space.
- 6 Click on Return.
- 7 Click on Add Photo to create another activity.

8. I DESCRIBE ONE OF THE ARTIST'S WORKS

ACTIVITY 2 : Create a Sound Board

- 1 Click on Camera and Albums and now select one of your favorite works by the artist you chose.
- 2 Click on Add Activity.
- 3 Click on Create a Sound Board.
- 4 Trace a shape around each of the details you choose to include (colors, shapes, contrasts, media, symbols, anecdotes, etc.).
- 5 Click on + and record your commentary for this detail.
- 6 You can add as many details as you like.
- 7 Click on Done.
- 8 Click on Add Photo to create another activity.

5. I WRITE A SHORT INTRODUCTION

I write a short introduction to the artist I chose. I include his / her country of origin, date of birth, the artistic movement with which he / she is associated, an anecdote, etc.

6. I COLLECT MY IMAGES

I search the Internet for copyright free images: the artist's works, photographs of him / her. etc. I copy these to my photo gallery so I can use them later. I follow the same process on YouTube to find interesting videos about my artist. This time, I take note of the links and bookmark them.

7. I CREATE MY PRESENTATION

ACTIVITY 1 : Say Something

1	Click on the Tiny Tap app and create your account.
2	Click on Create + to begin.
3	Choose a background by clicking on Backgrounds.
4	Select a photo of the artist and one of his / her works by clicking on the magnifying glass.
5	Click on Add Activity.
6	Click on Say Something.
7	Record your introduction to the artist.
8	Click on Done.
9	Click on Add Photo to create another activity.
