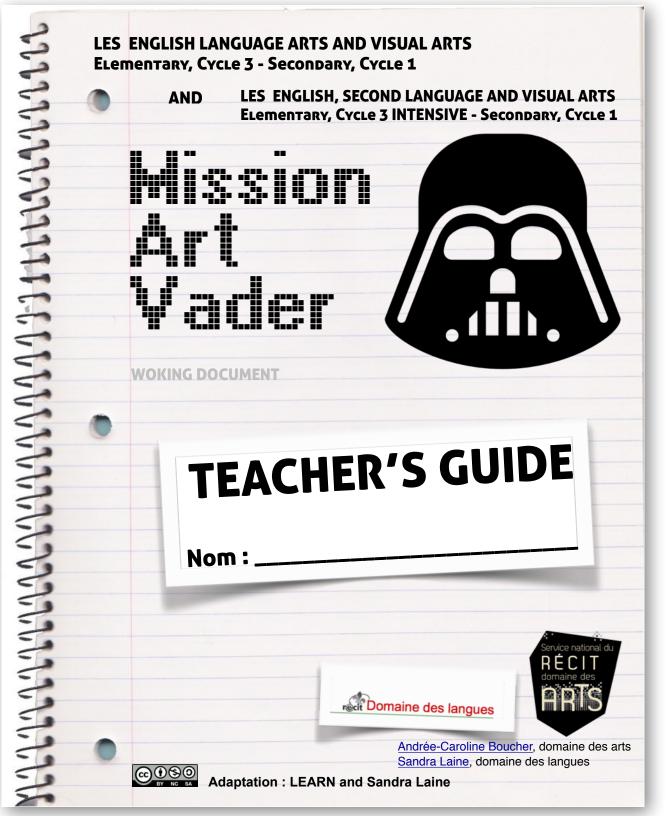

1	Play The Scenario video. <u>http://recit.org/ul/pag</u>
2	Introduce the Student Booklet.
3	Ensure that the students fully understand their "mission" by reading the transcription of the message to them.
4	Form teams (optional).
5	Brainstorm with students about who they know as major artists. Guide them to do Internet research to discover new artists. We suggest that you center the brainstorming around artists who have been deceased for at least 50 years in order to avoid copyright issues since the students will have to find images by these same artists.
6	Ask the students to select an artist they would like to learn more about.
7	Ask the students to brainstorm about their chosen artist. This information can be taken from the Internet and then transcribed in their Student Booklet.
8	Activate the students' prior knowledge by asking them what they know about gaming.
9	Introduce the Tiny Tap app. (Tutorial) Explain the various activities that this app will allow them to create. Create a class account.
10	Explain that they should create as many activities as possible so they can advance as far as possible as a JedArtist. They should share as much information as possible about their selected artist.
11	Create each activity by following the steps for Tiny Tap that can be found in their Student Booklet.
12	Share their games on the Tiny Tap Website so other students can appreciate them.
13	13. Give each student a JedArt rank according to the number of activities he . she creates: 1) PadanArtist (Apprentice JedArtist) 2) JedArtist Knight 3) Master JedArtist. See <u>Symbol Resource</u> .
13	Invite the students to play each other's games so they can discover as many artists as possible.
